



# Community Health Excellence Grants

## Helping our provider partners deliver innovative care

Founded in 2009, the PacificSource Community Health Excellence (CHE) grants program has contributed more than \$10 million in funding to nearly 400 contracted providers across Oregon, Idaho, Montana, and Washington.

Each CHE application is independently evaluated based on patient impact. To be considered, proposed projects must benefit all patients and be payor-neutral.

Recently funded projects have addressed clinical pharmacy integration; provider workforce and pipeline development; culturally and linguistically appropriate outreach to patients; and more.

### CHE grants seek to:

- Advance the quadruple aim through collaboration and innovative engagement between PacificSource and providers.
- Foster an environment of continuous improvement among providers who practice in communities PacificSource serves.
- Elicit the diverse capabilities of provider organizations in ways that make a significant, positive health impact for unique patient populations.
